## **School Health Related Services Script for MA Discussion With Parents**

The purpose of this script is to provide school professionals with a suggested text to begin a medical assistance billing conversation with parents/guardians.

By law, school districts can receive funding from public health plan for health related special education services.

State legislation requires the district to ask you for insurance information If your child currently has Medical Assistance (MA) or Minnesota Care (MNC), the covered services would be paid for without affecting your limits or co-pays.

## **Covered services** include:

Physical and occupational therapy, speech, language and hearing therapy, nursing, personal care, mental health skills training, assistive technology devices, special transportation and certain assessments.

The **money school districts receive** from billing health related services is used to offset the cost of employing medical service providers.

Your decision regarding third party billing **will not** affect the special education services offered to your child.

Medical assistance billing information will be **discussed each year** at your child's IEP meeting.
