# OCCUPATIONAL SKILLS PROGRAM

CENTRAL LAKES COLLEGE BRAINERD, MN



### The Occupational Skills Program is a 9 month Technical College Program.

- The Goal: Entry level competitive employment.
- Courses focus on Independent Living Skills and Job Seeking and Keeping Skills.
- Students can earn a Diploma upon successful completion of the Program.

#### **CLASSES**

Communications, Employability Skills, Study Skills, Computer Basics, Critical Reasoning Skills, Supervised Pre-Internship

In addition to the OSP courses, students take a minimum of 2 credits outside of the program.

#### **SUPERVISED PRE-INTERNSHIP**

- Students work a minimum of 12 hours per week to gain work experience in a career area of interest.
- Students take public transportation to their work sites.
- Students are guided and monitored by OSP staff.
- OSP Partners with a variety of businesses throughout the Brainerd/Baxter area to provide students with opportunities to gain entry level work skills in fields such as:
  - Custodial, Foodservice, Retail, Warehouse/Manufacturing, and Entry level Child Care & Nursing Homes

#### **ADMISSIONS PROCESS**

- Students may apply after September 1st for the following Fall Semester start.
- Complete the general application to Central Lakes College. Be sure to specify Occupational Skills Program for your choice.
- \*After your application is received at our admissions office, you will get a Phase 2 packet.
- Complete the Phase 2 packet and return necessary materials to OSP Coordinator.
- \*Attend an information sharing meeting with OSP staff.

#### HOUSING

- OSP is NOT a supported living program.
- Student housing is located on west end of college property.
- Multiple apartment complexes are also located across the street from campus.
- The majority of OSP students secure an apartment with one or more roommates, also in OSP.
- Most OSP Students receive assistance from Semi-Independent Living Skills services (SILS).

#### A FULL COLLEGE EXPERIENCE

- OSP students participate in a campus club of their choice. Some examples include: Right Brain Media, Horticulture Club, Natural Resources Club, Equality Coalition, Marine and Small Engines, Diversity Club, Psychology Club, Welding Club.
- Students are highly encouraged to attend/participate in: sporting events, theater productions, music events, and Student Life sponsored events.

#### **FINANCIAL AID**

- \* All Occupational Skills Program students should fill out the FAFSA form. It can be found at www.clcmn.edu under financial aid. Students may be eligible for Federal and/or State grants.
- Students should also explore the possibilities of scholarships through their home high school or local civic organizations.
- Students may also apply for scholarships through the CLC Foundation by going to www.clcmn.edu under financial aid.
- The cost of the program is right around \$12,000 for Tuition, Books, Housing
